Implementation Status and Key Decisions

- The digital census cartography activities are progressing and on track for a census enumeration in December 2020. The GIS laboratory will be operational by September 2019 to analyze satellite imagery in preparation for the cartography field operations and to produce georeferenced databases from collected data. The cartography field operations are currently planned for the period from January 2020 to July 2020.
- The implementation of the Harmonized Household Living Conditions Survey is delayed. However, the recent recruitment of a resident technical expert by the project will help accelerate preparations and improve data quality. The auxiliary non-standard units survey is nearly ready and should be launched in September 2019. Also, initial drafts of the household questionnaire and methodological documents have been produced. Following some additional revisions, the documents will undergo a technical review by Bank experts in September 2019. The first wave of data collection for the main survey is scheduled to start in February 2020.

- The 2018 national accounts (provisional) were produced in June 2019 in accordance with internationally recommended publication timelines - a first for CAR. In addition, the plan for rebasing national accounts and transitioning to the SNA 2008 was produced. The year 2020 will be targeted as the new base year, and key source data will include the population census, household survey, and agricultural survey among others.
- The expanded price data collection for the revision of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) has been ongoing. The price data collection has
 been expanded beyond the capital to 5 prefectures as security conditions have improved. Given delays in implementing the Household
 Budget Consumption survey, the project decided to use the Household Living Conditions Survey to define the new CPI basket and
 weights for the revised CPI series.
- As the agricultural survey requires a revised sample frame based on the census cartography, preparations have not yet been initiated. However, planning will begin by October 2019.
- The data collection for the third edition of the National Commune Monography Survey was launched in August 2019 and should be concluded in September 2019.


