Implementation Status and Key Decisions

A restructuring of the project was processed in August 2014 to address the emergency situation in Sierra Leone due to the Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) crisis. The restructuring will allow for an emergency response to support the Government of SL which faces an urgent need for assistance to support its response to an increasing number of people infected with the EVD. The proposed changes include: (i) revising the PDO to include the support of the emergency response needed to contain and control the Ebola crisis; (ii) adding a Component 3 (*Emergency Response to Ebola Crisis*); (iii) reallocating US\$6 million from Component 1(*Strengthening of Service Delivery*) to finance Component 3; (iv) revising implementation arrangements by amending the procurement plan to allow potential contracting of UN agencies and/or other international organizations/NGOs to deliver emergency services to the population and by changing the disbursement arrangements to use UN Advance procedures for the new component; and (v) revising the Results Framework to reflect changes in the scope of the Project. The project has already fully disbursed the reallocated US\$6 million.

Progress towards the achievement of the PDO has been downgraded from Satisfactory to Moderately Satisfactory because of implementation delays due to EVD and reduced utilization of health services due to the EVD outbreak Implementation Progress rating remains Moderately Satisfactory given the good progress in implementing the EVD response activities under Component 3.
