Implementation Status Overview



Work on key areas which will contribute to meeting the development objectives are on target and therefore the project is on track to meet development objectives. Below is a summary on implementation progress under the project components:

- -Rationalize National Social Protection Policy. The Government is in the process of undertaking a review of the existing safety nets programs with a view to identifying shortcomings and improving effectiveness of the Social Safety Nets programs in Ghana.
- -Livelihood Empowerment against Poverty Program (LEAP). The LEAP target for 2010 has been achieved. The LEAP program is in the process of scaling up and deepening from a pilot to a national program. This expansion is accompanied with tailored capacity building efforts both at national and district level staff to align the institutional and operational arrangements with growing needs of the program. Currently, LEAP is reaching 45,000 households.
- -Labor Intensive Public Works (LIPW). Progress is underway. The districts have been selected and capacity building efforts in 40 districts are ongoing. Two workshops have been held to sensitize district officials from all target districts.
- -Capacity Building and Project Management and Coordination. These activities are under preparation and are gradually being integrated into the various components based on action plans and synergies among the activities.

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


