#### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Overall, the project has made good progress and continues to maintain a good implementation pace and progress toward its development objective despite serious security challenges and enhanced AGE demands from SPs. In total, the project has disbursed US\$213.12 million. The MOPH successfully conducted the first Semi-Annual Performance Review of Sehatmandi service delivery which clearly indicates that the pay-for-performance (P4P) approach has improved data use and increased the focus on and measurement of performance. The third-party monitor is now onboard to verify service providers' performance based on Health Management Information System reports and to assess the quality of services through the Balance Score Card.

The MOPH successfully conducted two quarterly and the first Semi-Annual Performance Review of the SPs in September 2019. The process brought together representatives of all MOPH technical departments, Performance Management Office, Grants Contract Management Unit, service providers, and representatives of development partners. The performance review highlighted that 18 out of the 34 provinces are exceeding their



index targets of the P4P indicators. Antenatal care, postnatal care, and outpatient visits for children under 5 years exceeded the P4P indicator caps in over half of provinces.

All the five conditions for the release of the second tranche of ARTF for Sehatmandi project have been completed by MOPH and documentary evidence has been submitted to the Bank. The documentary evidence has presented to ARTF management committee and the committee approved the second tranche for US\$160 million.

The Mid-Term Review (MTR) of the project is planned for early June 2020.

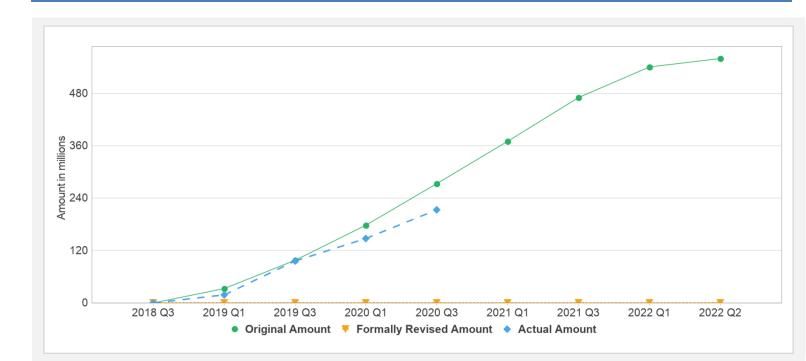
