- Approved Annual Development Plans.
- Core locally appointed staff to operate systems.
- Functional websites and automated systems for managing finances, complaints, and performance.
- Environment and social management focal persons; systems for preparation, approval, and supervision of investments; and capacity to develop and implement environment and social management instruments.

Achievement of these results, once duly verified, will lead to the successful MCs receiving the first Performance-Based Grant.
