### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Note: This ISR is being filed for compliance reasons as the original supervision and reporting plan was interrupted by COVID situation. Currently a virtual Implementation Support Mission is underway and a full ISR will be filed at May ending. The body of this ISR therefore has not yet been updated, but will be updated when the full ISR is submitted by May ending.

Over the past 6 months, the project has completed the registration of 104,612 farmers in its climate-smart agriculture database. Some 119,000 agroforestry trees have been raised for 478 demonstration plots, while plans are underway to scale up agroforestry practices to the registered farmers. The project has completed the mapping of location, tenure status and land use for large and emerging farms. The project is on course to

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deliver 9 Integrated Development Plans across the Eastern Province. Consultancies for the preparation Benefit Sharing, Greenhouse Gas Inventory, and Emissions Reduction Program Document are ongoing, though the stakeholder consultations involved in these activities have been severely impacted by COVID-19. Under forest management, the project supported the mobilization of Community Forest Management Groups (CFMGs), building the capacity of 435 farmers in Assisted Natural Regeneration (ANR). About 425 hectares of degraded land has been set aside for ANR across the Eastern Province, while selected Forest Reserves of Eastern Province have been supported to complete their forest inventories. A total of 104,246 hectares of land is expected to be brought under sustainable forest management.

The 3 key issues that the upcoming mission will focus on are:

- Assess project implementation progress, including progress towards achieving the project development objectives and intermediate outcomes;
- 2. Assess effectiveness and efficiency of project implementation; and
- 3. Discuss implementation and coordination management with a view to resolving outstanding implementation challenges

The mission will consider among others, modification of the results framework, options for reducing procurement delays, and possible restructuring to strengthen implementation management.


