Implementation Status and Key Decisions

There has been good progress on the pace of implementation under the project. The implementing agencies have improved their performance and have expedited the project activities. Disbursement rate increased from 23% in November 2016 to 36.3% as of April 7, 2017. With major procurement activities well under way in component 2, actual implementation on the ground is expected to start in July 2017 and disbursement will reach to 18% for component 2 by end of FY 17. Under component 1, contracts for implementation of 557 schemes will be signed with 106 Support Organizations (SOs) by June 2017. This will increase the disbursement rate to 48% by June 2017. The physical progress on the ground is also in line with this improvement in disbursement. The project implementing agencies- the Project Management Unit at Ministry of Water Supply and Sanitation (MoWSS_PMU) and the Fund Board need to continue the current implementation pace and improve in the coming months in order to keep the project on track to achieve its development objectives within the project period.

However, the Project Management Unit has started providing training to the Water User Committees and the initial activities are underway with support from the Project Support Team.


