#### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

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Since the last ISR disclosed in June 2018, the following was achieved: (i) the Additional Financing to the DFSP was signed in December 2018; (ii) School Improvement Funding (58,154 million MMK) was disbursed in May and November 2018 to 48,575 government and monastic schools; (iii) Stipends (15,025 million MMK) were transferred to 191,814 poor and vulnerable students over the 2018-19 school year; (iv) 599 teacher mentors were recruited and deployed to 150 townships and more than 20,000 mentees received in-school mentoring visits since the program was launched; (v) an early grade reading pilot, informed by the results of the Early Grade Reading Assessments, was rolled-out in 30 schools in Shan South; (v) new and strengthened safeguards processes were designed, presented in the revised Environmental and Social Management Framework (ESMF), disclosed on the Ministry of Education's website on January 25, 2019, and discussed in consultation meetings in Rakhine, Shan East, Nay Pyi Taw, and Yangon in February 2019.

Ongoing work focuses around supporting the Ministry in (i) revising and finalizing the ESMF on the basis of feedbacks received during consultations; (ii) revising the Operational Guidelines (OGs) for the School Improvement Support, the Student Stipends, and the Teacher Mentoring and Cluster Support programs to reflect lessons learned (see implementation support aide-memoire) and to integrate new and strengthened safeguards processes as described in the ESMF and delivering a new round of trainings to decentralized actors; (iii) disbursing the first tranche of Cluster Improvement Funds to support cluster-based meetings in complementing mentoring activities; (iv) finalizing the combined report on all EGRA and EGMA results; and (v) piloting innovative approaches to strengthen capacity, monitor implementation, and gather feedbacks from all stakeholders using information and communication technology (ICT).

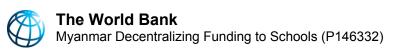

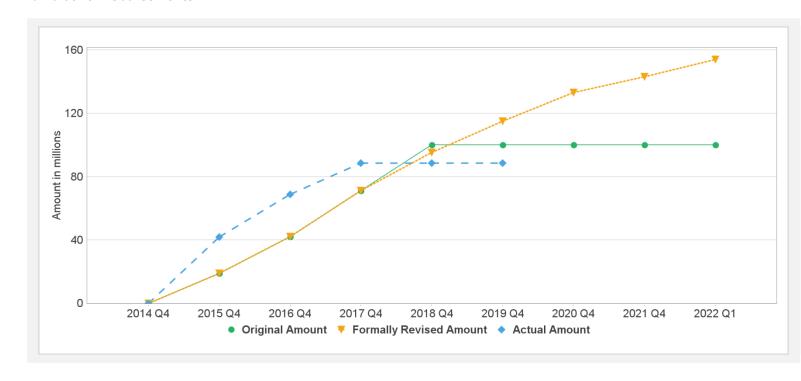
